The workshop begins with Alternatives to Violence basic training and continues with Trauma Resiliency, an experiential workshop to practice personal and cooperative tools to discharge and reprocess emotional pain or distress to face and heal from challenging experiences. The workshops close with training on discernment, practicing applications to the business of daily life.

Those who wish to experience the local peace and justice work initiative of Peace Place can stay on after the workshop days. This needs to be pre-arranged with the local team and the cost is separate. Those coming from afar, we encourage you to arrive 3 days before the workshop to settle yourself into the time difference.

INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS: Once you get a letter of acceptance from the organizers, please purchase your tickets. We recommend that you arrange your arrival and departure at <u>Ahmad Yani</u> International Airport in Semarang. We will send a separate arrival and departure information form in May to facilitate arrival and drop off. Please don't hesitate to message <u>Kins or Petrus</u> for some travel advice.

PASSPORT AND VISA: Be sure you have your passport valid for 6 months past your return date. Citizens from ASEAN member countries will not need visas to enter Indonesia for 30 days. Please plan to get your visas ahead of time and coordinate with the Indonesian Embassy in your country.

LOCAL TRAVEL: It takes around two hours to travel from Ahmad Yani Airport to Peace Place, depending on the traffic. We can arrange for an airport transfer for approximately 35-50 USD per trip. Specific instructions will be provided once registration is approved.

ACCOMMODATION: The registration covers board and lodging. You will need about US\$30/week for incidentals and may wish to travel with an additional US\$200-300, which may or may not be spent. Day trips to visit neighboring communities will be billed separately, but we keep costs as low as possible, and discourage excessive spending.





Medical and Security: Travelers are responsible for their own medical insurance. Please bring your prescription medicines from home.

Fees: We ask that you raise funds for the work, as we do not employ staff for fundraising, and this increases our outreach. If you can, we appreciate US\$400 or AU\$600 while in the country, and if you are able, US\$500 or AU\$ 750 for Friends Peace Teams to support the ongoing program. These funds are guidelines and not requirements for participation. We appreciate people who raise funds for the trip, which means volunteering your time to think about what the trip means to you, sharing that with others, and encouraging others to contribute to this work. You may let groups know about your trip before you go and then share your insights and learning upon your return. You may share our film, Silaturahmi: The Power of Visiting, arrange for an online interview with someone involved in the work and share your own commitment to this work.
